Re: **Please co-sign the Bilirakis/Maloney letter on Cyprus**

I am writing to ask your Member to please consider cosigning Congressional letters to President Bush, Secretary of State Colin Powell, and United Nations Secretary General Kofi Annan about the Cyprus situation.

In a recent Dear Colleague letter, Representatives Michael Bilirakis and Carolyn Maloney underscored that “the Government of Cyprus has emphasized that it remains committed to persevering in its efforts to reunify Cyprus as a bi-zonal bi-communal federation with democratic and human rights for all Cypriots.” They also asked their colleagues to “respect the democratic decision of the people, to remain engaged in efforts to resolve the Cyprus problem, and to work toward a fair and lasting reunification of Cyprus.” We share their support for the democratic process in Cyprus and, once again, respectfully encourage you to join their bipartisan initiative.
