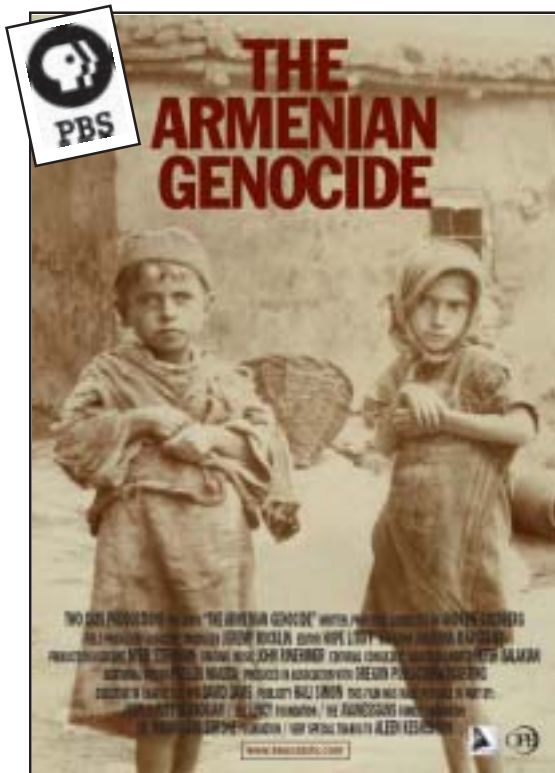

This Monday, April 17th please watch the powerful one-hour documentary, “**The Armenian Genocide**,” written, directed and produced by Emmy Award-winning producer Andrew Goldberg.

“The Armenian Genocide” will be shown in the Washington, DC area on Monday, April 17 at 10:00 p.m. on WETA (Channel 26) and again at 11:00 p.m. on MPT (Channel 22).

The film is narrated by Julianna Margulies and includes narrations by Ed Harris, Natalie Portman, Laura Linney and Orlando Bloom. Learn about the 20th Century’s first genocide, its lasting impact to this day, and the importance of Congressional legislation condemning this crime against humanity.
