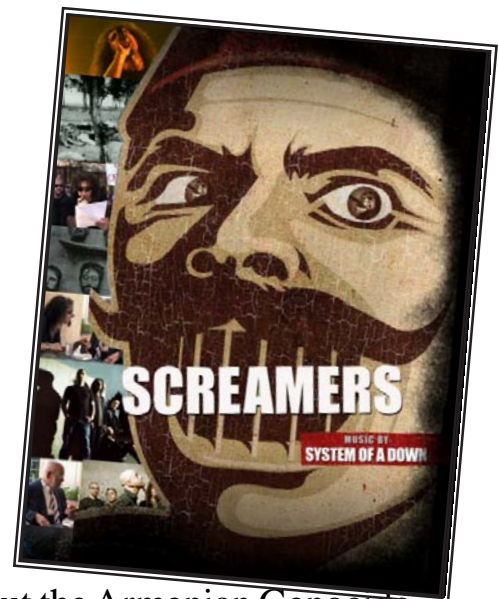

Vote Yes on H.Res.106: The Armenian Genocide Resolution

This resolution puts America back on the right side of a vital moral issue, reaffirming our nation's unique role in promoting human rights worldwide.

**We advance U.S. interests when we stand up
for the values of the American people**

H.Res.106 helps to end the cycle of genocide by showing that America's willingness to oppose genocide, past and present, is unconditional.

The precedent set by Turkey's denial and our own administration's silence only emboldens future tyrants to consider using genocide, secure in the knowledge that geopolitical leverage will shield them from condemnation.

- Before invading Poland in 1939, Hitler dismissed objections by asking: "Who, after all, speaks today of the annihilation of the Armenians?"
- Many of the same tactics used by the Ottoman Empire against Armenians in 1915 are being used again today in Darfur.

Broad-based Support

H.Res.106 enjoys bipartisan support from over 224 cosponsors and been approved by the Foreign Affairs Committee. It is endorsed by human rights, academic, faith-based, and ethnic groups representing millions of Americans.

The Armenian Genocide is officially recognized by 40 U.S. states and more than 20 nations, including 11 NATO allies.
